Purpose: To encourage academic achievement among high school students by awarding a scholarship to a graduating senior who is a resident of Richton Park.

Eligibility: THESE GUIDELINES MUST BE MET BY ALL APPLICANTS:

- ❖ Be a resident of the Village of Richton Park and submit proof of residency
- ❖ Have a valid Richton Park Public Library card
- ❖ Be a graduating high school senior and submit copy of student ID
- ❖ Enroll in a post-secondary institution
- ❖ Submit sealed high school transcripts with ACT and/or SAT score (*if available*)
- ❖ Submit a Short Essay or Resume

Scholarship

Grant: The amount of the award will be set annually and must be used for education related expenses.

Method of Selection:

Up to two (2) scholarships will be awarded. If the recipient does not attend a post-secondary institution, the scholarship will be forfeited and the award shall be made to an alternate. No monies will be awarded until proof of enrollment in a post-secondary institution is verified. The Scholarship Committee, consisting of three members of the Friends of the Richton Park Library, will determine selection of the recipient based on GPA, Class Standing, ACT or SAT score (*if available*), participation in extracurricular activities, and the submitted short essay or resume. The applicant with the highest committee ranking will be designated as the recipient and the next highest will be the alternate. In the event of a tie in ranking, the determination of the winner will be at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee.

General

Information: Applications will be distributed to area high schools in the spring of each year. Applications will also be available at Richton Park Public Library. **Applications must be received or postmarked by Friday, May 6th, 2022, 8:00pm.** Awards* will be determined by June. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered under any circumstances.

**By accepting the award, responsible parties agree that the names and photos of recipients can be used for scholarship publicity.*
